

Magone Home Aftercare Program (MHAP) is an aftercare facility of Don Bosco Boys' Home that provides a multi-disciplinary approach to help children in conflict with the law (CICL). Since 2010, we have assisted these young individuals who have been through rehabilitation and/or diversion programs as they prepare themselves to effectively reintegrate to society and to live independently.
