

EVENTS:

1. SPOKEN POETRY CONTEST

- a. This is an individual competition and is open to participating schools.
- b. Each school may send 1 representative each.
- c. The content of the Spoken Poetry must interpret the theme "Way Plastikay! Ikaw ug Ako Magtinabangay!"
- d. Solo performance with Costume and Props.
- e. At least 3 5 minutes piece.
- f. Must be in local dialect.
- g. No Foul Words
- h. Criteria for judging will be as follows:
 - g.1. Content and presentation 40%
 - g.2. Poise and spontaneity of Recitation 25%
 - g.3. Clarity of Spoken Words 25%
 - g.4. Audience Impact 10%
- i. Top 3 entries will be selected as winners.

2. POSTER MAKING CONTEST

- a. This is an individual competition and is open to participating schools.
- b. Each school may send up to 2 representatives each.
- c. The poster must illustrate, interpret and portray the theme of "Beat Air Pollution: Managing Solid Waste towards a Pollution-Free Environment
- d. The following materials will be used in the contest:
 - d.1. A 1/2 illustration board (white background & vertical format) and Mongol pencil (to be brought by the contestant).
 - d.2. Coloring materials: oil pastel/cray pas, markers, ink, oil, acrylic, mixed media, and watercolor (to be provided by the contestant).
 *Use of other materials not specified above is strictly prohibited.
 - d.3. The posters will be created on the spot on August 16, 2019.
- e. The posters will be judged according to the following criteria:
 - e.1. Presentation 40%
 - e.2. Originality 30%
 - e.3. Relevance to the theme 30%
- f. Top 3 entries will be selected as winners.

3. QUIZ BOWL

- a. This competition shall be participated by 1st year students.
- b. The quiz bowl will consist of three (3) rounds, namely: ELIMINATION, SEMI FINAL and FINAL rounds.
- c. Each round will have corresponding point equivalents for every correct answer.
- d. The elimination round will have 7 questions worth 2 points, the semi-final round will have 9 questions worth 3 points and the final round will have 7 questions worth 5 points.

- e. The allotted time for each question is 30 seconds.
- f. Questions shall be from the field of Environment and the DENR Structure.
- g. Questions shall be flashed on screen for the contestants and the audience to read while the quiz master reads the questions. The quiz master shall read the question before the timer starts. Teams may begin answering while the questions are still being read.
- h. Each group (consisting of three (3) members per group) will be provided with a black board and chalk on which they will write their answers.
- i. At the end of the allotted time, contestants must stop writing raise their boards to show their answers.
- j. In the elimination round, only the top 6 groups will qualify for the semi final round.
- k. At the end of the semi-final round, only the top 3 groups will move on to the final round.
