## DIVISION SPECIAL EDUCATION (SPED) OLYMPICS AND CULTURAL MEET 2019

- 1. This Office announces the conduct of the Division Special Education (SPED) Olympics and Cultural Meet 2019 on September 28 to 30, 2019 at Carmen, Cebu.
- 2. Public Schools District Supervisors, Principals and teachers of SPED Centers and schools offering SPED classes are hereby directed **to give their full support to this activity.**
- SPED teachers and coaches are directed to observe strictly the following activities:
  - submission and checking of athletes'/contestants' credentials to the Credentials Committee on Friday, September 20, 2019 at the Div. Office (Attn. Consolacion CS SPED Teachers);
  - submission of the final list of athletes/contestants for the different sports events and cultural contests on September 13, 2019 (Attn. Mr. Allan Mutya);
  - all delegates are expected to arrive at Carmen CS, Carmen, Cebu before lunchtime of September 28, 2019.
- 4. In as much as September 28 and 29, 2019 fall on Saturday and Sunday respectively, teachers and coaches who are involved in the activity are entitled to **two (2) days service credits** in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2011 and DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, while the non-teaching personnel and Division Supervisor/s are entitled to **Compensatory Time Off (CTO)** per CSC and DBM Circular No. 2, s. 2004.
- 3. Expenses for the meals of the whole delegation, travelling and other incidental expenses that may be incurred relative to the conduct of this activity shall be chargeable against **school MOOE/SEF/PTA funds**, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 4. Please refer to the enclosures for the names of Officiating Officials and athletes/contestants, schedule of activities and playing venues.
- 5. This Memorandum serves as participants' Authority to Travel.
