1. This office announces the conduct of the Area Science Fair and Competition 2019- Secondary Level with a theme "Science for the People: Enabling Technologies for Sustainable Development" on different dates and venues by cluster as stated below:

- The following should be strictly:
  - A. Parents' Consent signed by both father and mother or guardian allowing their child to participate the competition is needed.
  - B. Registration fee for the Area Level Competition-Secondary is 50php/contestant and 70php/coach to defray the expenses for the certificates, medals, simple decoration and honoraria and food/snacks of judges are chargeable against School Club Funds/ Local School Board/ SEF/ PTA Funds, while transportation, materials and other related expenses to be used in the contest with official receipts and per dime incurred in connection to the activities shall be chargeable to Local/School MOOE or any available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
  - C. It is encouraged that austerity measures be observed in these activities.
- 3. This Memorandum serves as **AUTHORITY TO TRAVEL** of the participants, coaches, Secondary Science Coordinators, School Heads, Working Committees and PSDSs in the Area Level Competitions.
- 4. PSDSs and School Heads are directed to minimize the no. of teachers to go with the district delegation for the Area Level and to ensure that **NO classes** will be left unattended due to the attendance /participation of the teachers to these activities.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
