The research-oriented webinar will focus on the events that happened in Cebu during the Philippine-Spanish revolution. Dr. Mojares will also discuss unexplored narratives, lesser-known facts, and things Cebuanos need to know about the revolt.

Dr. Mojares is a multi-awarded author, scholar, and a notable cultural and literary historian. He served as the founding director of the Cebuano Studies Center from 1975 to 1996. He has written numerous books and scholarly articles on history, literature and politics, including *The War in Cebu* (2015). He was conferred the Order of National Artist in 2018, the first Cebuano to have received the highest award given to artists in the country.
