



Profile of Speakers Fighting a Modern-day battle: Inspirational Leadership During Times of Uncertainty #WaterBottleSession





Ana Patricia Non, also known as "Patreng", was the first woman to lead the founding of Community Pantry in the Philippines. The first community pantry in the country was assembled in Maginhawa, Quezon City. It first distributed foods such as vegetables, noodles, sardines, and some essential foods on Wednesday, April 14, 2021.

Ana Patricia Non attended the Paco Catholic School during her high school years. She took a Visual Communications course at the University of the Philippines - College of Fine Arts and became a member of the UP Artists' Circle Fraternity and Sorority and. During her college years. she conducts free art workshops in the villages. She also had programs for farmers, factory workers, political prisoners and indigenous Lumads.



Abby Banuag is a Kool Adventure Camp (RAFI CFL) Alumnus. He works as the Psychological Services Supervisor at Magone Home Aftercare Program-a private facility of the Salesians of Don Bosco designed to provide intensive aftercare treatment to a child in conflict with the law (CICL) Magone Homes has been a partner of RAFI Center for Leaders in providing intervention and learning and development opportunities for CICL since 2013. He is also currently working as a consultant at Municipality Anti-Drug Abuse Council of the Municipality of Consolacion Community Based Rehabilitation Program.

Abby is a Psychology graduate of Cebu Doctor's University in 2013 and has a master's degree in Clinical Psychology at the University of San Carlos.
