PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS' PROPORTIONAL VACATION PAY COMPUTATION FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Public Schools District Supervisors Elementary and Secondary School Heads District/School Bookkeepers All Others Concerned

- 1. This office hereby informs the field for the computation of PVP for SY 2020-2021 per DepEd Memorandum No. 044 s 2021.
- 2. All concerned are required to follow the calculation provided in the said DepEd Memorandum.
- 3. Schools with teaching personnel (Newly Hired and Provisional) who are not yet integrated in the Payroll Services Unit are required to submit the PVP Report and Summary of Absences with supporting documents to the Division Accounting Office on or before August 13, 2021 for the processing of July 1-31, 2021 and August 1-22, 2021 salary depending on the equivalent PVP days.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.

INTERIM GUIDELINES ON THE COMPUTATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS' PROPORTIONAL VACATION PAY FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021

To: Regional Directors Schools Division Superintendents Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned


- Pending the official issuance of the school calendar for School Year (SY) 2021-2022, this is to provide the field offices the interim guidelines on the Computation of the Proportional Vacation Pay (PVP) for SY 2020-2021 for all public elementary and secondary school teachers, which is in pursuance to Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular (CSC MC) No. 40, s. 1998 as amended by CSC MC No. 9, s. 2012.
- For SY 2020-2021, each of the teachers who rendered continuous service from June 1, 2020 to July 10, 2021, shall be entitled to 59 days total of PVP from school break and Christmas vacation days, computed as follows:

Total Number of days served = 405 days from June 1, 2020 to July 10, 2021 Less: Number of Christmas vacation days earned -16 days from December 19, 2020 to January 3, 2021 Actual days served ≈ 389 days Multiply factor x 0.152Total PVP earned from the number of School Break = 59 days and Christmas vacation days Less: Number of Christmas vacation days = -16 days Number of School Break vacation days earned = 43 days from July 11 to August 22, 2021

Factor 0.152 shall be used for the computation of absences and PVP for SY 2020–2021. Below is the computation of the **derivation factor of 0.152**.

Number of Summer vacation days = 43 days Add: Number of Christmas vacation days = <u>+16 days</u> Total PVP 59 days (Summer and Christmas vacation days) Divided by actual days served = 389 days Multiply factor = 0.152

Per DepEd Order (DO) No. 007, s. 2020 titled, School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021, teachers were directed to officially report to work starting June 1, 2020. Considering this, the reckoning period on the computation of the total number of days served shall commence on the said date until July 10, 2021, as prescribed under DO 12, s. 2021 titled, Amendment to DepEd Order No. 030, s. 2020 (Amendment to DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2020, School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021).



- 5. In the interim, the computation of the number of School Break vacation days is based on the earliest date of SY 2021-2022 school opening as proposed by the Department of Education to the President. Necessary adjustments on teachers' remuneration shall be accordingly made in the event that the proposed opening of classes is declared on an earlier or later date.
- 6. This Memorandum is issued without prejudice to other benefits and other privileges that may be afforded to public school teachers during the period of the COVID-19 Pandemic, as may be allowed by law.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
