MORATORIUM ON THE REQUEST FOR SCHOOL REDISTRICTING AND SCHOOLS DIVISION RECLASSIFICATION

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents Chief Education Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors/Districts-in-Charge Elementary/Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. This is to inform the field about the "Moratorium on the Request for School Redistricting and School Division Reclassification" as stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 057, s. 2021 dated 18 August 2021 as herein attached.
- **2.** The SGOD Office is temporarily **not** accepting documents for redistricting or creation of new schools districts pending the release of the new guidelines or criteria based on the above-mentioned Memo, and as per DepEd Memorandum No. 026, s. 2021 dated 12 May 2021.
- **3.** In this regard, municipalities or towns that plan to create additional districts are advised to keep on file the necessary or required documents pending the issuance of the new guidelines or criteria.
- **4.** This is for the information and guidance of all concerned.

MORATORIUM ON THE REQUEST FOR SCHOOL REDISTRICTING AND SCHOOLS DIVISION RECLASSIFICATION

Undersecretaries To: **Assistant Secretaries** Bureau and Service Directors Regional Directors Schools Division Superintendents Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

Pursuant to the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9155, otherwise known as Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001, Section 5.2 stipulates that:

A school district already existing at the time of the passage of the Act shall be maintained. However, an additional school district may be established by the Regional Director based on criteria set by the Secretary and on the recommendation of the Schools Division Superintendent. For this purpose, the Secretary of Education shall set standard and formulate criteria as basis of the Regional Director in the establishment of an additional school district.

- The Department of Education Central Office (DepEd CO), through DepEd Memorandum No. 026, s. 2021 created a National Technical Working Group (NTWG) to Review and Revise School Districting Policies. This undertaking shall propose appropriate and relevant revisions to the current organizational structure, delineate functions in the positions under the schools division offices (SDO) and evaluate manpower complement that would have an impact on the performance of the Department. Revisiting and updating relevant policies and standards related to the school district shall be the major deliverables of the NTWG.
- In view of the foregoing, all redistricting requests endorsed to DepEd CO. including those that are pending for tagging in the Learner Information System (LIS) and Basic Education Information System (EBEIS) from the regions and SDOs shall be put on hold until an updated policy and guidelines related to school redistricting have been issued. In addition, since schools district is one of the criteria for the size classification of the SDOs, requests for SDO size reclassification shall also be held in abeyance until the redistricting policy has been issued.
