- 3. The Division Search for Brigada Eskwela Best Implementer Schools shall be categorized into four (4) Small, Medium, Large, and Mega Large school.

  - d. Highest Generated Resources;
  - e. Best Brigada Eskwela Collaboration at the School District; and
  - f. Most Prepared School among others
