## RESULTS OF THE SCHOOL SITES' INVENTORY AS PER DIVISION MEMO NO. 265, S. 2021

**To:** Assistant Schools Division Superintendents Chief Education Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors/District-in-Charge Elementary/Secondary School Heads

- **1.**The Office hereby informs the field on the results of the school sites inventory conducted by the SGOD Office. The data collected revealed the following:
- 1.1 Only 3.7% or a total of 42 school sites had been titled (special patents) to DepEd Division of Cebu Province;
- 1.2 Twenty-seven percent (27%) or a total of 302 school sites are owned by DepEd by tax declaration only;
- 1.3 Only 344 school sites are owned by DepEd by land title or tax declaration only or 30.85% out of the 1, 115 elementary and secondary schools in the Division; and
  - 1.4 Seventy-three (73) school sites (6.5%) are still owned by private individuals.
- 2. The following districts have 100 percent (%) DepEd ownership status as regards to the schools in the district:
  - **2.1Alcantara = 100% (11 schools)**;
  - 2.2 San Fernando 2 = 100% (16 schools);
  - 2.3 Tudela = 100% (13 schools); and
- **2.4 All schools in Pilar** are donated to DepEd but the tax declarations are still to be transferred in the name of DepEd Cebu Province.
- **3.**The following districts have more than 90 percent (%) DepEd ownership rate:
  - 3.1Argao 1 = 92.3% (24 schools out of 26 are owned by DepEd);
  - 3.2 Boljoon = 92.80% (12 schools out of 13 are owned by DepEd); and
  - 3.3 San Fernando 1 = 93.75% (15 schools out of 16 are owned by DepEd).

**5.**The are **344 schools** that are qualified to apply for titling/special patent based on the initial evaluation, in this regard, school heads of these schools need to immediately prepare the documents for submission to CENRO for the application of special patents, provided, that none of these school sites are considered as timberland, mineral land, watershed areas, foreshore lands and other lots which are classified as patrimonial property of the state. If the school sites are considered as protected areas under special laws, only the tax declaration/s shall be in the name of the school or DepEd Schools Division of Cebu Province.

6.For titling purposes, school heads need to prepare/have the filled-up request for issuance of school site special patent, historical background of possession/occupation of the lot, recent photographs with panoramic view and improvements, court certification of no pending land registration case (from RTC or MTCC), deed of donation/deed of sale (any document proving acquisition), latest tax declaration (in the name of DepEd or the school), lot status and A & E certification from DENR-CENRO, and other supporting documents proving possession or ownership of the school site (e.g. geodetic engineering survey plans or subdivision plans).

7. The school heads of the 344 schools may submit to the SGOD the needed documents (for titling) for preliminary evaluation before these will forwarded to CENRO Argao Office for the South and CENRO Cebu City for the schools in the northern part of Cebu Province. Submission must be done by district for easy tracking of documents.

- 8. The school heads of the 73 schools whose school sites are still owned by private individuals need to work with the respective municipal School Boards so that an offer to buy to these school sites can be immediately done, and if not, possible expropriation must be resorted to by the respective LGUs. A continuing appropriation must be provided regularly/annually in the school board budget as regards to school sites' acquisition.
- **9.** Based on the inventory, there are **698 schools** (out of the 1, 115 schools/62.65%) which are currently owned by the respective municipalities and/or barangays, in this regard, school heads/district supervisors need to work directly to the heirs of the original lot owners for the execution of an amended deed of donation (the lots must be directly donated to DepEd not to the municipality or the barangay).
- 10. There are also schools which are named in favor of the deceased donors/private individuals but the school sites were not donated to DepEd, in this regard, school heads of these schools need to submit the needed documents regarding the change of names to these schools; heirs must be informed that the lot or parcel of land must be donated directly to DepEd not to the municipality or the barangay, if this will not be corrected, these schools need to be reverted to the old or previous school name.


