ADDENDUM TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NUMBER 430 S. 2021 ENTITLED "CONDUCT OF ORIENTATION FOR THE TEACHER INDUCTION PROGRAM (TIP) MODULES 3-6

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief, CID and SGOD Division Supervisors/Coordinators All Others Concerned

- 1. This Office informs the field on the additional important matters to consider relative to the conduct of the District Orientation for Teacher Induction Program (TIP) on Modules 3-6 from November 2-5, 2021, to wit:
 - a. Expenses for meals and materials incurred during the entire duration of the activity shall be charged against **local/School MOOE** subject to its availability and usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
 - b. All districts shall conduct Completion Ceremony on the last day of the seminar-workshop;
 - c. Submit Activity Completion Report (ACR) to EPS II -HRD, Mr. Louie Monteroso on before November 29, 2021;
 - d. Districts with less than five (5) participants may opt to merge with the neighboring districts;
 - e. All those teachers who were not able to join in the TIP-Modules 1 & 2 conducted last March, may be allowed to participate in the roll-out for Modules 3-6, provided, they will comply with all expected outputs for Modules 1-2.
- 2. All other matters stipulated in the previous memorandum remain the same.

3. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.

CONDUCT OF DISTRICT ORIENTATION FOR THE TEACHER INDUCTION PROGRAM (TIP) MODULES 3-6

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief, CID and SGOD Division Supervisors/Coordinators All Others Concerned

- 1. This Office informs the field on the conduct of District Orientation for the Teacher Induction Program on Modules 3-6 from **November 2-5,2021.**
- 2. This activity aims to orient and capacitate the participants regarding the full implementation of the Teachers Induction Program (TIP) in the entire Division of Cebu Province.
- 3. Participants to the said activity are the newly-hired teachers who were attendees of the TIP for Modules 1-2 conducted by Sub- Offices last March 2021.
- 4. To ensure that effective and efficient implementation and delivery of the Teacher Induction Program for Modules 3-6, all Public Schools District Supervisors and the select three School Heads per district who attended the Virtual Orientation on Teachers Induction Program of all PSDSs and Select School Heads last August 18-19, 2021, must plan out for the up-coming orientation at the district level.
- 5. The facilitators assigned in various topics during virtual orientation initiated and organized by the Division Office, only presented the overview and the parts of the modules and how to run and present the modules to the participants during the actual conduct of the face to-face orientation. But in the district level orientation, you need to let the participants be actively engaged and answer the pre-test, post-test, and all the activities and assessment per module. So it is expected that the district orientation on the TIP for Modules 3-6 would run for almost a week.
- 6. To help you out in the preparation, the SEPS-HRD is hereby preparing the actual **Training**Matrix that you will follow during the district orientation. Please refer to enclosed attachment.
- 7. In this connection, all PSDSs, with the assistance of the District HRD Coordinators must submit hard copy of the Learning and Development Program Design for the district orientation of the TIP on or before **November 2, 2021** through the **SEPS-HRD, Maria Socorro N. Relacion**. Please ask the help of the District HRD Coordinators as to the crafting and template.

- 9. To ensure that TIP for Modules 3-6 are fully implemented as planned, the members of the DFTATs are directed to conduct monitoring for this purpose from **November 2-5, 2021** to their respective areas of assignment.
- 10. This Memorandum serves as the **Authority to Travel** of all PSDSs, DFTATs, and all personnel involved in the activity.
