5. Each Schools District shall organize District Monitoring Team to assist the Division Monitoring Teams mentioned above. Indicated hereunder is the composition of District Monitoring team; viz:

- 6. The District Monitoring Teams shall chair by the Public Schools District Supervisor or any one of the School Heads or Master Teachers, who are not serving of the said electoral process but with NO relative running for any position. Strict adherence to all issuance relative to this matter is hereby directed.
- 7. For both Secretariat and Call Center, the District Chair shall choose any DepEd personnel who are committed to do the job.
- 8. You are entitled to have an overtime pay for your services on May 9, 2022 or three (3) days service credits/CTO/Leave credits, subject to availability of funds and existing auditing rules and regulations as well as pertinent Civil Service Law.
- 9. All concerned personnel are hereby directed to accomplish Daily Time Record (DTR) and prepare an Accomplishment Report. Submit the said documents to this Office on or before May 13, 2022.
- 10. Travelling, food (meals and snacks) and other incidental expenses to be incurred by each personnel shall be chargeable against School/Division Funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 11. This Memorandum serves as **Authority to Travel.**
- 12. Immediate and wide dissemination of, and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
