BRIGADA PAGBASA TEACHER'S TRAINING AND SEMINAR WORKSHOP

1. In response to the call to intensify the advocacy for reading under the *Hamon: Bawat Bata Bumabasa* (3Bs Initiatives) issued under DepEd Memorandum No. 173, s. 2019, the External Partnerships Service (EPS) has committed to make every learner a reader by engaging partners and stakeholders to promote the culture of reading.
2. Relative to this, this Office hereby informs the field the conduct of the Brigada Pagbasa Teacher's Training and Seminar-Workshop in the districts of Bantayan, Sta. Fe and Madridejos on September 5-9, 2022 at Bantayan CES at 8:00AM – 5:00PM in partnership with World Vision Development Foundation, Inc.
3. Participants in this activity are the Selected School Heads, District and School Reading Coordinators, PTA Officers in the districts of Bantayan 1 & 2, Madridejos and Sta. Fe and some identified SDO Personnel. TWG and participants from the island are allowed to be at the venue on Day 0.
4. Minimum public health standards shall be always complied with for the whole duration of the aforementioned activity. Informing the field that participants must be fully vaccinated and must present their vaccination card upon entry to the venue. Unvaccinated participants must present negative antigen results valid within 48 hours prior to arrival at the venue upon entry. Requesting 2 Division Nurses to be at the venue to attend to some health concerns and observance of health protocols.
5. Food, snacks, venue, accommodation, tarpaulin, travel, and other incidental expenses incurred during this activity shall be charged against Division HRTD/MOOE Fund/PSF/Local and Other Funds while traveling expenses of the participants shall be chargeable against School MOOE/Local School Funds.
6. This Memorandum serves as the Authority to Travel of participants.
7. Wide dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are hereby requested.
