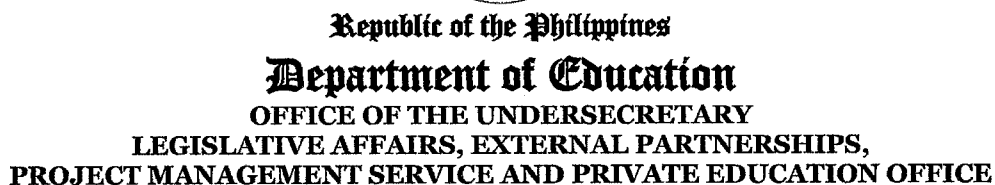
1. This Office shall be conducting the annual implementation of the “BRIGADA ESKWELA (BE) PROGRAM ACTIVITIES” on August 1-26, 2022 with the theme “Brigada Eskwela: Tugon sa Hamon ng Ligtas na Balik-Aral”. The Division Brigada Eskwela Kick-off Program will be held on August 3, 2022 at Cordova National High School from 8:00 A.M to 12:00 P.M. hosted by District of Cordova.
2. All District Offices are also encouraged to hold their kick-off ceremony in their respective areas after the division kick-off program with limited face-to-face participation and strict adherence to health protocols observed.
3. This year’s BE shall focus on the following:
 - a. implementation of the year-round schools’ maintenance and repair activities, which includes the provision of the immediate needs during disaster or calamities, and the addressing of resource gaps during the reopening of the face-to-face classes;
 - b. strengthened partnership engagements with partners and stakeholders that complement DepEd’s efforts to ensure quality basic education;
 - c. achievement of significant goals which shall contribute in increasing students’ participation rate, reducing drop-outs and helping improve learning for both learners and community; and
 - d. creation of a network of community-based organization to get total community commitment for collaborative programs and projects including the *Brigada Pagbasa* and other support and volunteer/community-based projects.

Participants in this activity are the Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Division management Committee, all Public Schools District Supervisors and District Partnerships Focal Persons of Liloan Sub Office, School Heads and School Partnerships Focal persons of Cordova District, partners (LGU, NGOs and Private Individuals). Informing the field that participants must be fully vaccinated and must present their vaccination card upon entry to the venue. Unvaccinated participants must present negative antigen results valid within 48 hours prior to arrival at the venue upon entry. Requesting 2 Division Nurses to be at the venue to attend to some health concerns and observance of health protocols.
5. Minimum public health standards shall be always complied with for the whole duration of the aforementioned activity.
6. Food, snacks, venue, accommodation, tarpaulin, travel, advocacy shirt, and other incidental expenses incurred during this activity shall be charged against Division HRD/MOOE Fund/PSF/School/Local and Other Funds while traveling expenses of the participants shall be chargeable against School MOOE/Local School Funds.
