Relative to DepEd Order 31 s. 2012 on Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of K-12 Basic Education Curriculum (on Learning Areas and Time Allotment) and Regional Memorandum No. 0261 s. 2023 on PRIMER: The Regional Harmonized Guidelines in the Implementation of Special Program in Science, this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) is releasing the attached Class Program for the Special Program in Science in Elementary and Junior High School for SY 2023-2024.
- 2. The release of this Memorandum aims to harmonize the class program in the implementation of the Special Program in Science in both Elementary and Junior High School with regards to learning area offering; time allotment and inclusion of the science and special subjects in the program offering.
- 3. While the expected change in the curriculum is still on hold, the field is hereby advised not to offer non-SPS subjects with nomenclature not consistent with DO 31 s. 2012 i.e SIKAP, Values Education and GMRC and further advised to offer the harmonized subjects in Special Science and Elective courses (ICT, Creative Technology and Science Research) for SY 2023-2024.
- 4. The implementing schools are given the freedom to create their Weekly Schedule taking into considerations the number of sections; availability of specialized/trained teachers to handle special science subjects and electives.
