CONDUCT OF THE REGIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE CARAVAN

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Region and Division DRRM Coordinators
Public Elementary and Secondary Schools heads
All Others Concerned

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS), in its commitment to climate action and as mandated by the Republic Act 9729, otherwise known as the Climate Change Act of 2009 provides, among others the role of the Department of Education (DepEd) in integrating in its plans, programs, policies, and activities the concepts of climate change, specifically:

“... DepEd shall integrate climate change into the primary and secondary education curricula and/or subjects, such as, but not limited to, science, biology, sibika, history, including textbooks, primers and other educational materials, basic climate change principles and concepts.”

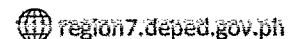
2. The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) is the lead focal and coordinative unit of the Department in Climate Change Adaptation (CCA) and performs the following specific functions:

- a) Act as focal point for DepEd in planning, implementing, coordinating, and monitoring of activities related to Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) and Climate Change Adaptation (CCA).
- b) Initiate and coordinate cooperation and collaborative activities with the national government agencies (NGA's), non-government organizations (NGOs) and civil society organizations (CSOs), inter-agency and cluster groupings such as National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) Technical Working Group (TWG), Education Cluster, Protection Group, among others concerned with DRRM/CCA.

3. In relation to this, the Department of Education Region 7 would like to conduct the Regional Climate Change Caravan (RCCC) on October 13, 2023 at the island of Cebu (specific venue and details to be determined). The participants on this activity are the 4 representatives from the Division Offices, DepEd Regional Office personnel, National

Government Agencies (NGAs), Civil Society Organizations (CSO's) Non-Government Organizations (NGO's) and etc.

4. Furthermore, all schools throughout region are encouraged to intensify further on the conduct of climate change adaptation and mitigation activities. All pre-caravan activities must be documented and submitted and to be shown during the schedule of the Regional Climate Change Caravan. In addition, schools and offices had already video/photo documentation during the Earth Day, Environmental Month Celebration (tree planting, clean-up and other related climate change adaptation activities conducted on this FY 2023) is requested to submit their video/photo documentation on and/or before September 8, 2023 through email ranilo.edar@deped.gov.ph and to be submitted to DRRMS on September 11, 2023.

Expenses incurred during the conduct on this pre-caravan activities and transportation and per diem of the participants to the Regional Climate Change Caravan shall be charged to MOOE while food and accommodation shall be charged to DRRM Comprehensively Released Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
